

Freie Hochschule Stuttgart – Information on the start of the study program and on the courses

Status: 10.09.2020, :14:00 Uhr – valid from Monday, 14.09.2020

We look forward to welcoming you all back to the Freie Hochschule Stuttgart!

We are pleased to inform you again about the current situation at the Freie Hochschule Stuttgart regarding the Corona Pandemic and the planning of the start of studies in WS 20/21.

The study courses start on Monday 14th September 2020. Regulations for the individual departments can be found below.

Students will be invited for the opening celebration by the course leaders or the course administration. Studierende werden für die Eröffnungsfeier von ihren Kursleiter*innen bzw. Kursbetreuerinnen per Mail eingeladen. All upcoming lessons can be found in the current timetable.

Important: If you are staying in a country declared a risk area by the German Foreign Office, you may only enter the university after a quarantine period of 14 days. The quarantine period can be shortened if you have a corona test five days after your return and the test is negative. Courses in the rooms of the Freie Hochschule are again possible.

Accordingly, the following regulations continue to apply for the stay on campus and the use of the course rooms:

In support of the Ordinance of the State Government on infection control measures of 23.06.2020 (https://www.baden-wuerttemberg.de/fileadmin/redaktion/dateien/PDF/Coronainfos/200623_Corona-Verordnung.pdf , especially §2 Abs.3)

- Please avoid meetings of more than twenty people in the buildings and on campus of the Freie Hochschule Stuttgart. The minimum distance of **1.5 m to another person** should be kept if possible. (For courses other regulations apply.)
- The classrooms must be thoroughly ventilated after each lesson and after the last use by a study group. After the last lesson, the surfaces of the tables and door handles are to be cleaned by a study group (before lunch break at 12:50).. Cleaning agents are available.

If possible, the classrooms should then be left. After use at 16:30 the rooms are cleaned by the cleaning team of the university.

- Only authorised persons are entitled to use the rooms.
This includes:
 - Students, employees, Lecturers,
 - Key holders and residents,
 - Students with invitations from their course instructors or course supervisors
 - Guests of internal and public events with invitation

Public events on the university campus are again possible. They can be attended after prior online registration and with confirmation from the university. Further information can be found on the homepage of the university.

- According to the supplementary regulations to §3 paragraph 1 Corona VO (mouth and nose cover) the following applies: On traffic areas as well as on other traffic routes in rooms a non-medical everyday mask or a comparable mouth and nose cover must be worn.

Facilities of the Freie Hochschule Stuttgart

The following regulations are still valid:

Contact to the administration:

- You can still reach the telephone switchboard under this number 0711 21094 - 0 between 8:00 to 12:00 o'clock and from 14:00 – 16:30 Uhr Monday to Friday.
- The Studieninfo-Hotline 0711 210 94 – 32 can be achieved consistently :
Mo., Mi. von 8:00 – 17:00 o'clock; Di., Do. von 8:00 – 20:00 o'clock.
- Personal visits to the course administration are only possible in urgent cases. Please use consultation hours with as few visitors as possible and avoid group gatherings on the corridors. If possible, please use electronic communication. They can only be made by prior appointment (by telephone or e-mail).
- The offices of the course administration and the library are to be entered according to the regulations with mouth and nose cover; the respective distances to be observed are indicated in the offices.

Library:

- Lending and return of books only after prior notification (by e-mail to Frau Renkenberger).

Campus

- The entrance doors of all Campus buildings are open as follows: 7.30 and 16:30 o'clock.
