### Length of Course

If prerequisites are met, the course can be completed in three semesters (18 months). In exceptional cases, which include extensive previous Waldorf training and sufficient teaching experience – it may be possible to complete the course in one year.

#### **Tuition**

The course fee for the entire programme is 16.000 Euros.

There are possibilities of partial scholarships depending on need.
